| 1)The Particulars of its organization, functions and duties: | Sarupathar College, Sarupathar is a college of co-education, affiliated to Dibrugarh University. Established on November 14, 1970 with the objective of providing access to people aspiring for higher education, the college is situated in Dhansiri Sub-division of Golaghat district of Assam. |
| 2)The Powers and Duties of its Officers and Employees: | The institution is governed by the rules and regulations of U.G.C and govt. of Assam. |
| 3)The procedure followed in the decision making process including channels of supervision and accountability: | The college has a Governing Body approved by the Govt. of Assam. It is the authority of decision making and the institution complies with rules and regulations implemented by U.G.C, Dibrugarh University and the govt. of Assam. The Principal is the head of the Institution and acts as the secretary of the Governing Body. The college comes under Local Fund Audit which gives certificates and remarks regarding maintenance of financial transactions. The college has different bodies and cells to maintain all types of disciplines inside the campus. |
| 4)The norms set by it for the discharge of its functions: | The institution follows the guidelines of UGC, Govt. of Assam as well as the rules and regulation of Dibrugarh University. |
| 5)The rules, regulations, instructions, manuals and records held by it or under its control or used by its employees for discharging its functions: | U.G.C. Act 1956, College provincialisation Act 2005 of the govt. of Assam, guidelines of DHE, Govt. of Assam and rules made by Governing Body of the institution. |
| 6)A statement of the categories of documents that are held by it or under its control: | Files on administration and academic matters, rules, procedures regarding the functioning of the institutions are held by it or under its control. |
